DAY 1 (09 Jan): PHU QUOC ARRIVAL - GRAND WORLD

Arrive Phu Quoc airport, welcome by our driver and transfer to the hotel for check in and relax (Check-in time: 02PM)

Afternoon, transfer to visit: **Grand world**: everyone can experience 24-hours a day entertainment, from boat trips on the river, seeing an ancient citadel which is vividly recreated day and night. There is also the "Essence of Vietnam", walking through the city at night, enjoying super shows like the "Colors of Venice" that recreated a dazzling and romantic miniature of Venice, dinners at Phu Quoc night market, and enjoying music that played throughout the days and nights

DAY 2 (10 Jan): PHU QUOC - VINWONDERS & VINPEARL SAFARI

Phu Quoc United Center of Vinpearl group was built as a "one-stop-destination" that provides full services of entertainment, resort, shopping and dining that is active 24/7. This first "sleepless city" model marked a new beginning in the tourism strategy of Vietnam.

- Vinwonders: Vinpearl Land Amusement Park is a massive entertainment hub that contains several sections, including an outdoor water park, outdoor and indoor arcade center, an aquarium and shopping street
- Vinpearl Safari: Vinpearl Safari Phu Quoc has an area of 380 hectares, including a zoo and a safari. This place is home to more than 4,500 animals of 200 species, including more than 40 endangered and rare species, and a diverse ecosystem of about 1,200 plant species. Visitors going to Vinpearl Safari Phu Quoc have the chance to explore 10 habitats and experience the excitement of seeing animals roaming free for the first time in Vietnam

DAY 3 (11 Jan): PHU QUOC – ISLAND & CABLE CAR TOUR

(S.I.C TOUR)

07h30 – 08h00: Shuttle van picks you up at hotel/resort in the center

08h10: Visit Long beach centre – the largest entertainment center in Phu Quoc

09h00: Arrive to the harbor, get on a speed boat, strat exploring the island



Visit May Rut or Mong Tay island, Coral Park (visit the coral park, walking under the sea – own your cost) Gam Ghi/ Dua/ Roi Island: Enjoy 100% matural coral ecosystems. Water level 1-3m

12h00: Arrive **Thom Island**, experience:

- + Have **buffet lunch** in Mango restaurant
- + Entertain at Aquatopia Water Park top of Asia's Water Parks
- + Enjoy the **Theme Park** the Eagle Eye observatory, the roller coaster Moc Xa Thinh No
- + Check-in the beach

DAY 4 (12 Jan): PHU QUOC - HA NOI ARRIVAL - HALF DAY CITY TOUR

Having breakfast at hotel then transfer to the airport for flight to Hanoi – No guide Afternoon, transfer to visit:

- Ho Chi Minh Complex
- Temple Of Literature
- Hoan Kiem Lake, Ngoc Son Temple
- Take a green car tour around the Old Quarter

DAY 5 (13 Jan): HA NOI – NINH BINH (HOA LU & TAM COC)

Morning, meet our guide and transfer to Ninh Binh provice - located 110km from Hanoi to the South, **Tam Coc cave** may be one of the most spectacular sights in Vietnam. Along the Hoang Long river, vast limestone cliffs rise out of the rice paddies make Tam Coc somehow similar to Halong Bay, thus Tam Coc is also called Halong Bay – on-land. A river trip to Tam Coc and through three caves of Tam Coc is wonderful for photo hunters, especially when local residents come to harvest the rice planted along the river or when they transplant



seeding for the next crop. Next to Tam Coc is Hoa Lu, the relics of the ancient capital of Vietnam in 10th century. What remains are temples dedicated to the two heroes: **King Dinh and King Le** whom chosen **Hoa Lu** to build the citadel of the capital city. Though the temples are not wholly maintained, some precious antiques are still preserved well like: the whole-stone dragon thrones; wooden has-relieves and lacquered statues of King Dinh, Kinh Le and Queen Duong Van Nga who in turn got married to both of the Kings. End of day, transfer back to Hanoi.

DAY 6 (14 Jan): HA NOI – HA LONG (OVERNIGHT ON CRUISE)

Morning, the driver will pick up and direct transfer to Ha Long bay, which is about 160 km or 2.5-hour drive away. Stop half way to visit a handicraft workshop of fine clothes and embroidered paintings. Arrive in Ha Long City at 11:30 AM and check in aboard the booked junk right after the welcome drink is served. Start cruising while having lunch on board and enjoy the mighty bay view. Ha Long Bay meaning Descending Dragon Bay in Vietnamese as legend has it that it was where a holly dragon landed down from sky. The bay cruise will continue with up close sighting of **Dinh Huong Island**, **Ga Choi Island**, **Dog Island**, **Sail Island**, a visit to **Sung Sot Cave** and swimming stop at **Titov Beach**. Relax to enjoy the bay view at sunset, have dinner after, go fishing at 09:00 PM and spend a night on board.

DAY 7 (15 Jan): HA LONG – HANOI - SHOPPING

Wake up at 06:30 AM and refresh your body and mind with a Tai Chi exercise on the sundeck. Tai Chi is an ancient internal martial art often practiced in soft and gracefully slow moves to enhance internal harmony and vitality. Have tea and coffee onboard before proceeding to Titov Islet or SoiSim Island to trek and swim. Check out at 09:30, have a buffet brunch while cruising back to shore. Disembark at 11:00 AM to transfer back Hanoi Free time for shopping (3 hours) then have dinner at Indian Restaurat

DAY 9 (17 Jan): DA NANG -BANA HILLS

07:45-8:00: We'll come to pick you up from your hotel in Da Nang and then make our way to the breathtaking Bana Hills

Start your day by checking in at the Suoi Mo Cable Car Station, where you'll board a cable car and enjoy stunning views of the surrounding mountains as you make your way to Marseille Station.

Once you arrive at **Marseille Station**, you'll have the opportunity to visit the famous **Golden Bridge**. This stunning pedestrian bridge is held up by two giant stone hands and offers breathtaking views of the surrounding hills and forests.

Head to **Jardin D'Amour**, a beautiful garden filled with colorful flowers, fountains, and sculptures. Take a leisurely stroll through the garden and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere.

Next, you'll visit the **Linh Ung Pagoda**, a Buddhist temple known for its impressive statue of the Goddess of Mercy.

Afternoon

Spend your afternoon at **Fantasy Park**, an amusement park with rides, games, and attractions. Whether you're a thrill-seeker or prefer something more relaxed, there'll be exciting activities for your family at Fantasy Park. You'll end your day by exploring the fantastic view of Ba Na Hills from **King Peak** at an altitude of 1.487m. Return to the **Cable Car Station** and the Gateway, and our guide will transfer you back to the hotel.

DAY 10 (18 Jan): DA NANG – HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN – BASKET BOAT

Morning, free at leisure

Afternoon, transfer to Hoi An ancient town and join basket boat tour at **Cam Thanh Coconut Village**. Here, you will be enthusiastically welcomed by the local people, they will lead you to visit the creeks in the water coconut woods by **basket boats**. You will be instructed to fish crabs and you will see the performances of rowing basket boat by the local rowers

Afternoon, we discover **Hoi An ancient town** which are the famous **Japanese Covered Bridges**, the **Pottery Museum**, the 200 years old **Tam Ky House**, the **Chua Ong Pagoda** and the bustling market. We visit these sights on an exciting walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls which reflect the town's multi-cultural past.

Then depart by a boat from Thu Bon wharf on Bach Dang street and sail along the major branch of the lower section of Thu Bon river, enjoy the beautiful scenery along both banks of the river and the many boats bobbing on the waters. Before back to wharf you will have time to **drop paper flower lantern**.
